

Strictly Seattle 2019 Work/Study Scholarship Overview + FAQs



Velocity's Summer Work/Study Scholarship program provides financial aid to dedicated Strictly Seattle participants. Scholarship recipients work a total of 12-17 hours, checking in classes and providing facility upkeep. This is not a volunteer position and applicants must demonstrate respect, reliability and accountability. In exchange, Work/Study Scholarship participants receive partial scholarship to Strictly Seattle. Awards are given based on merit and demonstrated financial need.

WORK/STUDY FAQ

1. What is the Strictly Seattle Work/Study program?

Work/Study participants are a vital part of the Strictly Seattle community. They are an integral part of the check in and support structure for each intensive and event, and help us keep our facilities clean and safe. Participants receive a \$150 credit toward their registration fees.

2. What will I be doing as a Work/Study participant?

Work/Study participants work a total of 12-15 hours during the festival. Jobs include monitoring classes, sweeping studios, cleaning bathrooms, ushering and ticket-taking, tech assistance, clean-up, set-up, working the registration table, and artist transportation.

3. How do I submit a Work/Study Application?

To be considered for the work/study scholarship, please submit a completed application by **April 1st, 2019**. You can drop this off in the office, or mail us the application and deposit check to: Velocity Dance Center, 1621 12th Ave Seattle, WA, 98122

4. When do I need to submit my application?

Applications received before April 1st will be given priority, though if the deadline has passed and you are still interested in the program, contact Erin Johnson to confirm if space is still available.

5. Do I need to participate in the full Strictly Seattle intensive to be a Work/Study participant?

Yes. You must register for the full intensive, and be available to fulfill your work study duties during the time of the festival (i.e. work/study hours cannot be worked before or after the festival). Additionally, participants must be available for an introductory meeting on Sunday, July 7th from 5:15PM - 6:00PM.


6. When will I be notified about the Work/Study program?

If you submit your application by April 1st, we will notify you by or before **May 1st** so you have time to take advantage of the early bird registration discounts. Applicants who submit after April 1st will be notified on a rolling basis. Unfortunately, because we may have more requests than available openings, we are not able to accept all applicants. We do keep a wait list.




